


Parcel #1 contains 74.379 Deeded Acres with 73.448 Acres Tillable


Parcel #2 contains 74.294 Deeded Acres with 73.446 Acres Tillable

Based on Certified Survey by Madsen Land Survey Company on May 20th, 2011 Official survey furnished upon inspection or the evening of the sale. U.S.D.A – FSA Farm Program shows 54.75% Corn Base and 45.25% Soybean Base Based on entire farm calculation, 119 bushel corn and 37 bushel of soybeans, both direct and CC Yield Data.

Both parcels have access to public road on the south and easement to service road on the north plus drainage easements to Elm Creek across Parcel #3 lying north of Parcel #1 and #2 of which shall be sold separate after Parcel 1 and 2 sold, Parcel 1 and 2 will be offered on our Board System so they may be sold either separate or combined. Parcel #1 has Productivity Index of approximately 77.5 and Parcel #2 has a Productivity Index of approximately 74.2, these indexes included in this booklet.




PARCEL #1 SOIL MAP AND TYPES

PARCEL #3



Parcel #3 lays directly north and adjacent to Parcel 1 and 2 and contains a well graveled service road which connects with County Blacktop on east end of the property.

This Parcel will be given easement to Parcel 1 and 2 to access this service road and also cross subsurface easements to creek on the north of subject property, as Parcel's 1, 2 and 3 were part of the larger Dorendorf property, this also has the same percentage of corn and soybean base as Parcel 1 and 2, has approximately 50% Tillable and considering the Productivity Index given this Parcel would have approximately 53% Index, the southerly edge of this property has been surveyed and markers are in place, the northerly edge of this property is the center of the creek and according to County Records there are 85 acres deeded land, this is figure used for bidding purposes, actual land purchased may vary slightly but sale will be based on 85 Acres.

As stated on the auction poster this parcel has many different uses, has tillable farm land, has pasture and recreational area, has some commercial gravel for use by contractors, and also has a seclusion, privacy and beauty for possible building uses.
